

**TIMELINE: Ze'ev Jabotinsky**

**1880** – Vladimir Jabotinsky is born in Odessa, Russia.

**1903** – Jabotinsky joins a new Zionist monthly journal, “Jewish Life,” later renamed “Rassvyet”.

**1917** – The Jewish Legion, the creation of which Jabotinsky played a pivotal role, is formed.

**1920** – Jabotinsky and his Haganah defends Jerusalem against Arab riots.

**1921** – Jabotinsky joins the Zionist Executive but will quit over policy differences.

**1923** – Finds “Brit Trumpeldor,” or “Betar,” a Zionist youth organization.

**1925** – Establishes the Revisionist movement.

**1935** – Brings together the first conference of the New Zionist Organization.

**1940** – Dies at a Betar camp in Hunter, N.Y.

**1964** – Jabotinsky’s remains are reinterred in Israel.
